Barrett House

Officially opened in October 1986, Barrett House is Toronto's first residential care facility for people living with HIV and AIDS over the age of 18. Barrett House is a residence, not a hospice. It provides a dignified, caring and home-like environment for persons living with HIV and AIDS who require ongoing care. The home is equipped with an elevator, affording residents a more mobile environment.

Barrett House is a home which showcases six bedrooms, a spacious living room, dining room, den, kitchen and breakfast room overlooking a beautifully landscaped back garden.

Barrett House is dedicated to giving one-on-one attention to each of its residents. Professional care givers are present 24 hours a day, and volunteers and friends also tend to the residents' emotional, psychological and physical needs.

Admission Procedure

Admission may be made by the following methods:

- individual application,
- referral by a Doctor, Hospital, Hospice or Social Service agency,
- interviews conducted by Barrett House staff.
