Role Summary:

Reporting to the Director of Barrett House and St. Joseph's Residence or his designate, the Relief Worker enhances the dignity and quality of life of Good Shepherd's clients by delivering the necessary physical assistance and emotional support required by the residents of Barrett House and St. Joseph's Residence according to individual needs.

Justice, equality, dignity and acceptance of clients is aided through the assumed responsibility for assisting residents with personal hygiene and daily medication as required.

Through positive role modelling, the Relief Worker is responsible for the demonstration of the Mission, Vision and Values at work within the Good Shepherd Ministries.

Responsibilities for this position include the following:

- Assigned, as needed, to day, evening, overnight and weekend shifts.
- Assisting residents with personal hygiene and daily medication; preparation of meals; to assist in the admission of new residents with particular attention to their adjustment and well-being; to maintain daily progress notes and reports; general housekeeping; assisting residents in transferring to higher levels of care or in returning to independent living; to constantly maintain a high level of care and compassion which is reflective of a profound respect for human life. Additional duties are in accordance with the Role Description.

Skill, Nature and Scope:

- Demonstrated commitment to the Mission, Vision and Values of Good Shepherd Ministries is a requirement. The ideal candidate has excellent interpersonal skills, active listening, written and organization skills; Care Giver and First Aid/CPR certifications; the ability to prepare a varied nutritious diet for a diversity of appetites; the ability to relate effectively to residents who are experiencing discomfort, stress, emotional and physical isolation

Hours of work:

- Day, evening, overnight and weekend shifts, as needed.

Wages and benefits: \$15.66 per hour start rate and \$16.32 after successful completion of a probationary period.
