GOOD SHEPHERD MINISTRIES

Founded in 1963, Good Shepherd Ministries serves people who struggle with homelessness and poverty.

Good Shepherd Ministries responds creatively and effectively to the underlying causes of homelessness.

Good Shepherd Centre is a homeless shelter providing all services free of charge without distinction.

- Overnight shelter to 95 homeless men
- more than 1,000 meals and snacks daily
- Clothing distribution (200+ items daily)
- Resettlement and addictions counselling
- Medical care
- Daily drop in
- Pastoral care

Barrett House is Toronto's first residential care facility for people living with HIV/AIDS.

St. Joseph's Residence is a supportive housing residence for frail, elderly, formerly homeless men suffering from mental or physical health ailments.
